It is pretty easy to say that cancer has had a major effect on me. My childhood ended when I was ten and my dad received his cancer diagnosis. I grew up overnight and began having an adult role in my family. During all this, I lived through my dad's stem cell, heart, and kidney transplants. I also went through what it is like to have a parent's heart stop and for them to be revived. I have experienced my dad going into hospice care and grieving his death while he was still alive. Although I am extremely grateful that my dad is alive today, I still live in fear knowing that his cancer can claim his life at any moment.

None of this is fair and it needs to stop. The suffering needs to end. Children should not have to grow up too early or have their parent taken from them by the unforgiving and cruel nature of cancer.

This is why the patient support that LLS offers is so important. In 2021 alone, LLS provided \$241 million in financial assistance to over 42,000 patients and addressed the gaps in cancer outcomes and healthcare in underserved populations.
